During this Fiscal year, the Town completed 3 ADA curb ramp upgrades, installed 102 linear feet of compliant sidewalk, and retrofitted accessibility features at Brower Park. These improvements support the implementation of the Town’s ADA Transition Plan and improve accessibility to public facilities and pedestrian routes.
