There are so many simple and easy things you can do to keep the water in our rivers and creeks clean and beautiful. These are some simple steps you can take every day to help prevent stormwater pollution:

1. Never throw litter out of the car window or on the ground-put it in the trash can.
2. Never dispose of chemicals down the storm drain.
3. Wash your car over grass or at a commercial car wash, and use phosphate free detergents.
4. Keep your vehicle maintained to prevent leaks of oil and other fluids.
5. Never pile leaves and other yard debris over the storm drain.
6. Use fertilizers sparingly and apply according to the directions on the bag. Never fertilize when rain is in the forecast.
7. Sweep sidewalks, driveways, and gutters instead of spraying them off with a hose.
8. Clean up after your pet and dispose of waste in the trash can or flush it down the toilet.
