Let us know and we can be sure to include this information in the meeting. You can reach us by phone, email, or in person. We look forward to your input!

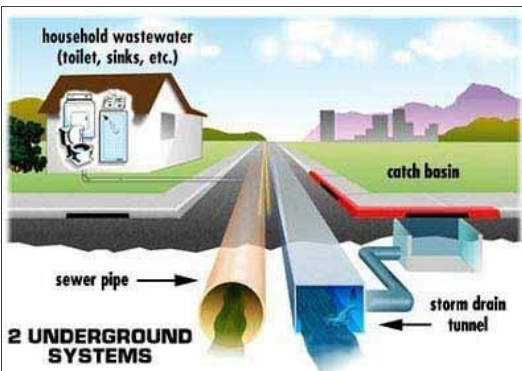


Archer Road Phase I Construction

The stormwater portion of the construction project that has the goal of reducing the runoff from the Brower Park baseball fields has been completed. Unlike wastewater that flows from your household toilets and sinks into the sewer system that leads to the wastewater treatment plant, stormwater isn't treated. Everything that enters our storm drain system goes straight into our local rivers, lakes, and creeks! Clean water is a clear choice!
